





## ≥ 1 Red Flag

#### **Immediate Review**

- Altered mental status P or U on AVPU
- Hypotension
- Prolonged central capillary refill
- · Tachycardia unexplained by fever/crying
- · Non blanching rash
- · Clinical deterioration as an in-patient

## ≥ 1 Amber Flag +/- Risk factors

### **Urgent Review**

- Inappropriate tachypnoea
- Altered functional status (e.g. severe leg pain, or inability to weight bear or
  - decreased activity)

    Healthcare professional concern
- Parental concern
- Increasing PEWS

- Immunocompromised
   Age ≤3 months
  - Chronic disease
    - Chronic disease
       Recent surgery
    - Break in skin (including chickenpox)
    - Indwelling line/device
  - Signs of infection in a wound (including chickenpox)
  - Incomplete vaccination record


# Septic Shock

Sepsis 6 bundle within 1 hour

#### Suspected Sepsis

Perform additional clinical and laboratory testing to assess for infection and organ dysfunction to support a diagnosis of sepsis Complete Sepsis 6 bundle within 3 HOURS of suspicion of sepsis
