HSE National Patient Safety Alerts (NPSAs)

High priority patient safety communications which require HSE and HSE funded services to take mandated specific action(s) within an identified timeframe in order to reduce the risk of occurrence or recurrence of patient safety incidents that have the potential to cause serious harm or death.

What does it mean for me as a patient or service user?: A HSE NPSA supporting infographic

- what a HSE NPSA is
- why it is being issued
- what it means for patients, service users or their families. It also outlines what (if anything) the patient, service user or their family may need to do if the alert is relevant to their care.
