

Guidelines for Submission of Abstract for Oral and/or Poster Presentation

Introduction

The National Clinical Programme for Sepsis in partnership with National Quality & Patient Safety Directorate welcome submissions for oral and/or poster abstracts for the 8th National Sepsis Summit Conference. We are delighted to be in a position to host this conference once again and to extend a warm invitation our medical, nursing, midwifery and HPSC colleagues across the country. We look forward to welcoming you to Dublin Castle on **Tuesday 3th September 2024**, to see and hear the excellent improvements & innovations undertaken to improve better patient outcomes for sepsis.

Application Process

- Application for oral and poster presentation is a competitive process
- A panel within the NSP will review each oral and poster abstract according to set criteria and identify those that are eligible to go forward for the conference
- There will be a limit of 6 oral presentations
- There will be approximately 30 poster presentations and a number of awards for the best in conference, announced on the day

Submitting an Abstract

- Submissions are open to medical, nurses, midwives & HPSC working in all hospital groups.
- Applications are welcome from individuals/teams that demonstrate commitment and excellence in improving the delivery of sepsis care.
- The initiative must already be completed or in the final stage of implementation.
- Abstracts submissions are made using the NSP Abstract Template provided and to a maximum of 500 words.
- Abstracts are to be submitted by the closing date of Friday 5th July 2024

Criteria for Selection

- Thematic Relevance: The abstract is relevant to the conference theme "Early
 Treatment Safes Lives"
- **2. Quality of Content:** Presented in clear and comprehensive language using the required headings and is understandable for people not familiar with the field
- **3. Originality:** The initiative brings a new perspective, approach or evidence on the theme of "Early Treatment Safes Lives"

All successful applicants will be informed in the week beginning **Monday 22nd July 2024.** The last date for poster submission will be **16th August 2024.**

Conflict of interest: If the author(s) have a financial or personal interest in products, technology or methodology mentioned in the initiative, please make this clear in the submission.

Copyright: Authors will be required to allow the NSP the right to publish the award winning submission. Please note, if you reproduce copyright material from other sources, such as diagrams or assessment tools, you are responsible for obtaining permission to do so and you will need to do so before making a submission.
